




Installation


Safety comes first









When installing EZ Glaze or doing maintenance work, always use stepping ladders or crawling boards, supported by minimum three roof structural elements.













Required Tools












- EZ Glaze 60 is designed for rafters whose width is 60mm or less.
- Distance between rafters must be 600 mm (center to center).
- Make sure the rafters are perfectly perpendicular to the beams/wall.
- EZ Glaze requires rafters support only, no purlins are required.


2 Minimum Roof Slope




• To ensure proper water runoff, slope should be at least 5% (50mm rise over 1m length).


* EZ Glaze - Installation direction recomendation






Set the EZ Glaze panels according to the direction recomendation instruction to reduce the cumulative deflection when installing a large number of panels.

Foam tape application (optional)




Applying foamed tape on each rafter will reduce friction and noise due to thermal expansion.

4 Setting the first EZ Glaze panel



- Set the first EZ Glaze panel on the rafters, leaving 50-150mm overhang.
- **Drill** 10 mm holes along the outer corrugation, every 500mm.
- First and last drills should be located 30mm-50mm from the rafter's top and bottom edges.


Fixing the first EZ Glaze panel



Fix the first EZ Glaze panel's outer corrugation, using specified screws and washers through the pre-drilled holes. Start at the bottom edge and work your way up.



6 Setting the second EZ Glaze panel




- Set the second panel, lateral overlapping the first one.
- Drill 10mm holes through **both** panels on the lateral overlap, every 500mm.

8 Completing the installation




Repeat stage 6 & 7 with the remaining panels.

7 Fixing the second EZ Glaze panel




Fix both panels together, using specified screws and washers through the pre-drilled holes. Start at the bottom edge and work your way up.

9 Applying Butyl tape






12 Side Wall Flashing (Purchased Separately)




* Side Wall finish when the panel is trimmed (Purchased Separately)














